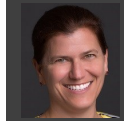

On Shavuot we put ourselves back with our ancestors at Mt. Sinai, trying to imagine the unimaginable: hearing God's voice, accepting the Torah as our guide, entering an eternal covenant with our people and our God. We will hear the 10 Commandments chanted by Karen Goldberg. Our mussar study will focus on Talmud Torah & *Kiyum Mitzvot* ~ **Study & Keeping the Commandments**, the lifelong activities we aspire to as Jews. Our service and reflections will include Yizkor, remembrance of our loved ones who have died, and a time to meditate on healing from the grief of their loss and the inspiration of their deeds.

Please bring a vegetarian dish to share for our potluck. We eat dairy foods on Shavuot to commemorate the 40 days that Moses spent on Mt. Sinai recording the Torah.
